

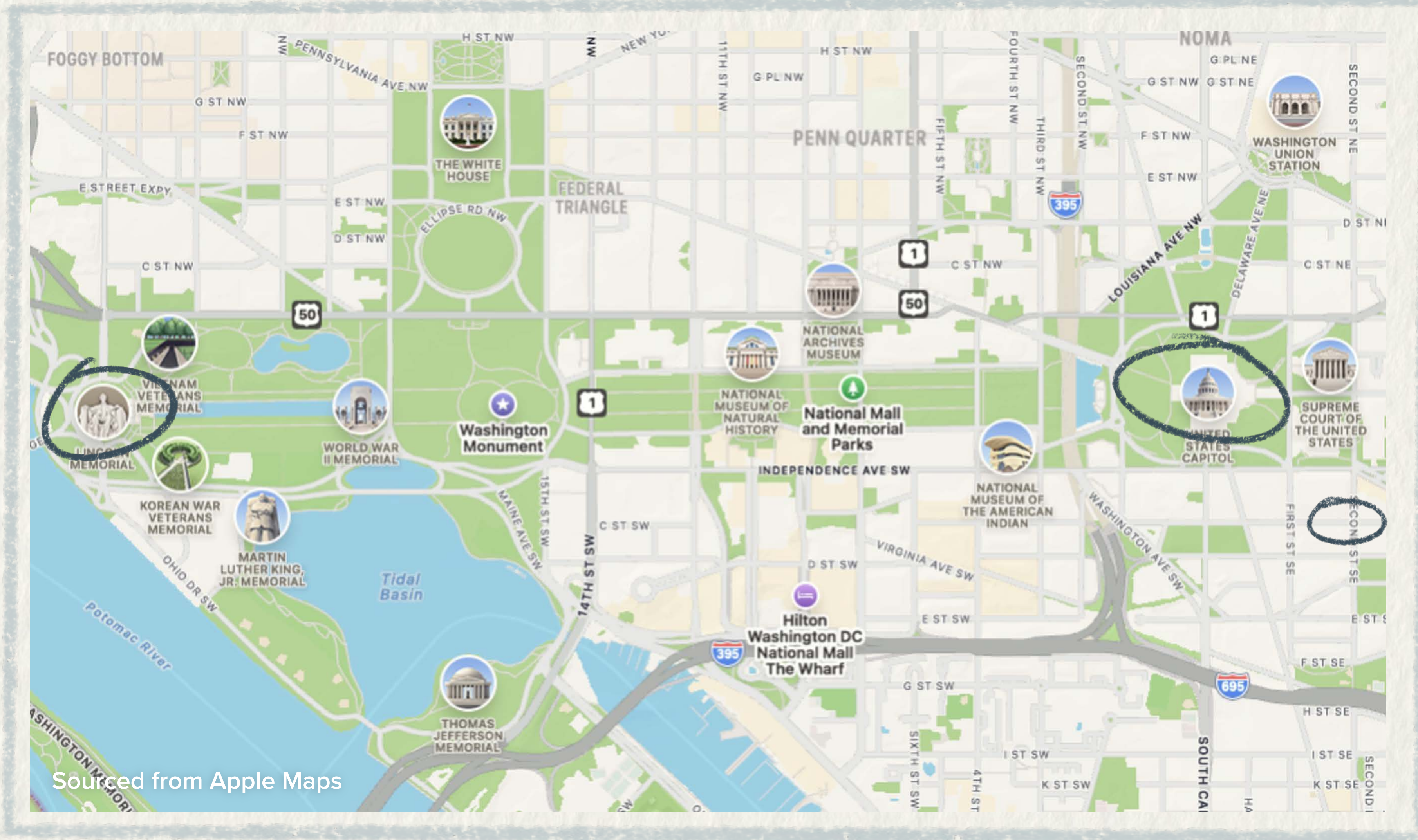

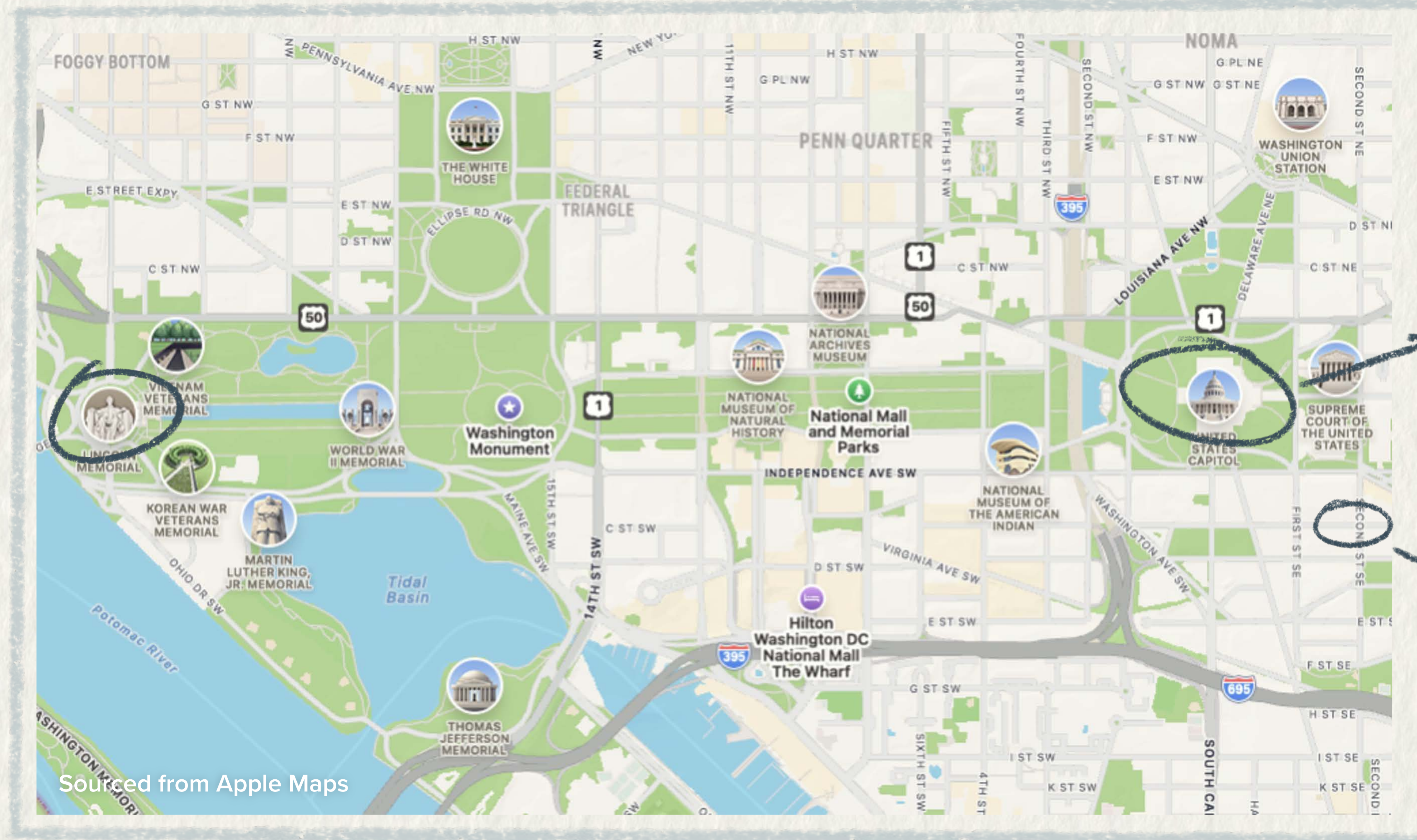

**Psalm 105:42-45** NIV


For he remembered his holy promise
