





Two Major Sections of Mark

Mark 1:27-28 ^{NIV}


The people were all so amazed that they asked each other, “What is this? A new teaching—**and with authority!** He even gives orders to impure spirits and they obey him.” ²⁸ **News about him spread quickly** over the whole region of Galilee.



Mark 2:1 ^{NIV}

A few days later, when Jesus again entered Capernaum, the people heard that he had come home.





Mark 2:2-4 ^{NIV}

They gathered in such large numbers that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and he preached the word to them. ³ Some men came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. ⁴ Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus by digging through it and then lowered the mat the man was lying on.

The roof

The house would have a flat roof
made of wooden branches
and across these wooden
branches would be laid

Mark 2:5 ^{NIV}

When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man,
“Son, your sins are forgiven.”



Mark 2:6-7 ^{NIV}

Now some teachers of the law were sitting there, thinking to themselves, ⁷ “Why does this fellow talk like that? He’s blaspheming!

Who can forgive sins but God alone?”



Mark 2:8 ^{NIV}

Immediately Jesus knew in his spirit that this was what they were thinking in their hearts, and he said to them, “Why are you thinking these things?”



Mark 2:9-12 ^{NIV}
